Enhanced Support

LifeShape: get access to 12-weeks' worth of WW (formally known as Weight Watchers) sessions delivered digitally or face-to-face as well as 1:1 buddy support from the One You South Gloucestershire team.

<u>Eligibility criteria:</u> over the age of 16, BMI above 30 (28 with co-morbidities or BMI ≥ 27.5 if Black-African, African-Caribbean, and Asian family origin) and a South Gloucestershire resident or registered with a South Gloucestershire GP.

MAN V FAT Challenge: access to a 14-week home-based programme that supports men to lose weight, based on the core principles of Nutrition, Exercise and Building Healthy Habits. Members work as a team to score points for completing challenges with support from the MAN v FAT Community and an experienced Coach.

Eligibility criteria: over the age of 18, male, BMI above 25 and a South Gloucestershire resident or registered with a South Gloucestershire GP.

Gloji: full access to a 12-week digital programme which includes support around food, activity, sleep, alcohol, and wellbeing. <u>Eligibility criteria:</u> over the age of 18, BMI above 30 (28 with co-morbidities or BMI ≥ 27.5 if Black-African, African-Caribbean, and Asian family origin) and a South Gloucestershire resident or registered with a South Gloucestershire GP.

Specialist Support

Weight Assessment & Management Service (WAMS): a specialist service for support with severe or complex obesity based at Southmead Hospital, Bristol. The WAMS service usually offers support over a 6–12-month period.

Eligibility criteria: BMI above 40 (35 or over if co-morbidities) and evidence of completing enhanced support, BMI ≥50 may be referred directly for surgery.
