



South Gloucestershire Harmful Sexual Behaviour Service

OnTrack is a specialist service offering support to young people and parents when a child presents with harmful sexual behaviour.

We are a team of specialists who work with children, young people, families and professionals who have been involved where an incident of harmful sexual behaviour (HSB) has been reported.

Your social worker might recommend that you meet with us to try and understand and address the behaviour in a helpful and supportive way.

If your child is still under Police investigation, we can work with the children's services team to provide support for you and your family through safety plans and signposting.

Your child must remain open to children's services and have a social worker for us to be able to work with them through OnTrack.

We provide:

- An assessment, which is called an 'AIM', to help you understand why the harmful behaviour occurred and how likely it is to happen again.
- Support to create a safety plan that will help you support your child. This might include changes within the home that keep everyone safe.
- Advice on therapeutic work that your child might require.

Intervention for HSB:

- Any intervention is tailored to the young persons' assessed needs.
- We have a future focus, wanting your child to be able to understand and develop safe, healthy relationships moving forwards.
- We try to establish triggers and causes of the HSB and address these.
- We will address any psychoeducational needs with regard to sexual knowledge.
- We will be open and honest, and encourage you and your child to express any concerns.
- We will always work in an honest, respectful and compassionate way.
