Our multi-agency training programme supports professionals and volunteers to develop the skills and confidence they need to identify concerns early, respond effectively, and put children at the heart of every decision.

Training Levels

Introductory

Introduction to Child Protection

Core multi-agency course for anyone working with children or families. Covers recognising abuse, referral pathways, and working together effectively. Refresher every 2 years unless advanced training is completed.

Advanced

Advanced Child Protection

For those with safeguarding lead roles or who take part in child protection processes. Explores thresholds, investigations, and complex casework.

Refresher

Advanced Child Protection Update

Biennial update for those who've completed Advanced training. If overdue, the full Advanced course must be retaken.

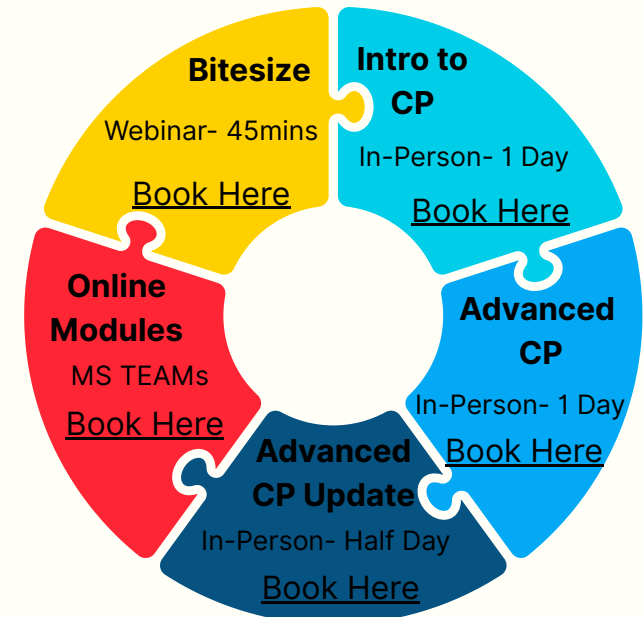
