

# SGSAB Annual Report Single Page Summary 2018-2019

SGSAB met four times in 2018-19 and has an independent chair – Tony Oliver

The SAB became statutory in 2015

Key agencies in South Gloucestershire have a representative on the LSAB

276,677 people live here

52,004 are over 65

1074 concerns were raised

This led to 561 542 enquiries

Most referrals were about Neglect (37%)

Most people are over 65 and have physical needs

The multi agency training offer for people who work with adults continued to be successful

658 people trained

308 MCA training

98% felt confident

80% attendance rate

95% of providers are rated good or outstanding by CQC
