

Summary Feedback for South Gloucestershire Safeguarding Adults Board (SAB) 8th Sept. 2016

Minutes of 9th June 2016:

These minutes were agreed. All the actions had been completed or well underway.

Quality Assurance Sub-Group:

The group has now finalised the new data reporting system and the Q1 results will go to December SAB along with the multi-agency audit which will be completed at next QA sub-group meeting on 3rd November.

Training Sub-Group:

- Joint conference with Bristol being held on 11th October 2016. Details will be sent out 13th September 2016.
- Continue to explore variety of ways of delivering training.
- Develop the website as a resource library.

Communications Sub-Group:

- Feedback on 'Stop adult abuse week'.
- Board voted on new logos for Safeguarding Adults Board and Safeguarding Children's Board.

Policy Update:

• Organisational Safeguarding practice guidance agreed with minor changes. TOR presented.

Safeguarding Adult Reviews Sub-Group

- This group met for first time in July 2016.
- Notification of 4 deaths of women at Eastwood Park Prison and clarification of adult safeguarding relationship with prisons.
- SCIE methodology training agreed for 2 board members.

Strategic/Working Plan:

Specific item about support/work with perpetrators deferred to next meeting. Otherwise on track.

Board Manager/Budget Update:

Board agreed the development of a joint Board Manager (position is for 2 years) with Safeguarding Children's Board, and Budget for 2016/17 and initial funding from Better Care Fund.

Making Safeguarding Personal:

- Feedback from first year's questionnaire for service users was presented.
- Option of following up with more in depth interviews to be discussed by Sub-group Chairs.

National and Local Updates:

- SA Boards Consortium meeting 07.09.2016 details to be provided for next SAB.
- Effective April 2017 Sirona no longer providing services to B&NES will move to Virgin and this will have implications for representation at various meetings including SAB.
- The Police and Crime Commissioner's draft Police and Crime Plan features vulnerability as a central priority. - South Glos CCG working closer with Bristol and North Somerset CCG's.
