**Daniel Lloyd attended the SGSAB to give an annual update about the work of the CQC. Daniel's role covers South Gloucestershire and Bristol.**

**Improvements are currently being made in the CQC under the direction of a new Chief Executive and new chief inspector in the region. The South West is covered by 7 teams. In South Gloucestershire 95% of service are either good or outstanding. Nationally this figure is 83.5%**
