AT THE BOARD

- The board began with a personal story of an adult who experienced financial abuse, to help members focus on the reason for meeting
- A joint learning event with the SGSCB is due to take place on 26th November on the theme of Think Family
- Updates received from all sub groups – board members were reminded about the importance of consistent attendance at sub groups in order that the work of the board can be effective.

SAFEGUARDING ADULT REVIEW

The board had a presentation from Kate Spreadbury, an independent consultant engaged by the board, of a Safeguarding Adult Review the SGSAB have been undertaking. The review was accepted by the board.

SAB SELF AUDITS



Four Safeguarding Adults Boards have been working together to produce a self-audit for organisations working with adults across South Gloucestershire, Bristol, Bath and North East Somerset and North Somerset.

This audit was agreed at the June board meeting and was on the agenda at the September board in its final format for board members to review.

The self-audit will give the four boards a comprehensive set of data from partner organisations about their safeguarding arrangements.

The self-audit will be completed by all partners by 31st October 2018 and returned to one of the four boards, in order that the information can be compiled into a single report that will be presented to the board in early 2019.

RISK REGISTER

The board adopted a template for a SGSAB risk register, which will be a new standing agenda item going forward at future board meetings.
