REPORTING CHILD ABUSE – MAKING THE CALL

Each local authority has a dedicated children's social care team, and you should call them if you think a child or young person is at risk of, or is being abused or neglected.

While it's understood that you might not have all the answers, the following are the kinds of things you might be asked:

- Details about the child, such as name and date of birth
- The reason(s) for your call

Each of us has a role to play.
