Top Tips for Completing a SERAF

Provide a clear analysis of the information contained within the SERAF

Use your professional judgement to analyse the risks to the child – CSE and other risks

Make sure the SERAF includes the views of the young person/ parents / other professionals where possible

If you are completing a review SERAF make reference to changes in score/ indicators/ risks

Note whether it is vulnerabilities, moderate or significant factors that make up the score and analyse this

Include recommended actions
