There are nine steps outlined for Boards that include, leadership, workforce development, culture, listening to service users and mental capacity.

- *Evidence strong leadership of Making Safeguarding Personal
- *Promote and model the culture shift required for Making Safeguarding Personal
- *Define core principles for strategy and practice
- *Promote and support workplace and workforce development
- *Seek assurance of and support development of competent practice in applying the Mental Capacity Act
- *Ensure there is clear focus on prevention and early intervention
- *Engage with communities and those who may be in need of safeguarding support
- *Facilitate engagement of all organisations across the partnership in developing Making Safeguarding Personal
- *Measure the difference Making Safeguarding Personal makes for people
