Paul Chapman presented to the board on behalf of CQC for South Gloucestershire.

In South Gloucestershire there are

- 62 Care Homes without nursing
- 43 Domiciliary Care services
- 23 Care Homes with nursing
- 6 supported living services
- 5 extra care housing services
- 2 Community Health Care Services

A team of eight inspectors conducted 168 inspections across Bristol and South Gloucestershire last year.
