## INDEPENDENT CHAIR

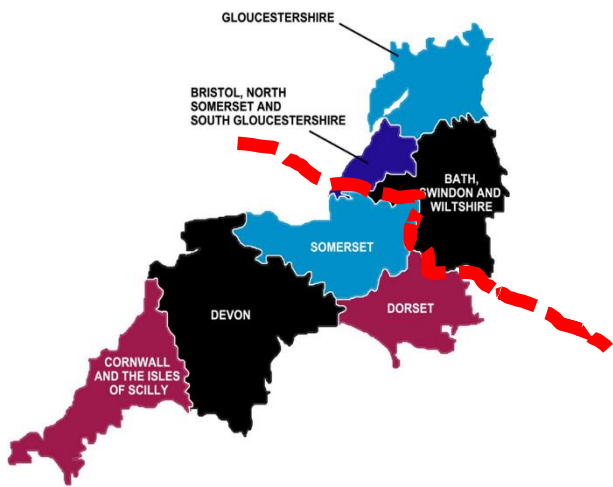
