



## 1.13 Special schools and specialist provision

### Special Schools, Resource Bases and Access Centres in South Gloucestershire

The vast majority of children with special educational needs including those with Education, Health and Care plans are educated in mainstream schools. In South Gloucestershire we have a number of Special schools, Resource bases and Access Centres. These settings meet the needs of our children with Education Health and Care Plans who have the most complex special educational needs.

#### Placement process

The decision to allocate a place at a specialist setting is undertaken at the Local Authority Statutory panel. At this panel a multi-agency team from Education, Health and Social Care consider the evidence submitted. This evidence may be gained either as part of the annual review process or as part of an Education health and Care needs assessment. This evidence will include submissions from parents/carers, the child, schools and advice writers from Health, Education and Social Care. Before and after panel the Education, Health and Care Plan team will undertake casework which will ensure that the all parties are informed as to their choices. Parents and children and young people will have an opportunity to explore these choices and be informed of the LAs legal duties and their appeal rights. It is important to note that in the absence of parental preference the local authority must name mainstream provision.

## Resource Bases and Access Centres
