Additional Guidance for Requesting Early Years EP Involvement

Essential Information to Provide:

- ART form see below for additional completion advice
- Information Sharing Consent form appropriately completed and signed by Parent/Carer
- Information to Support Request for EP Involvement in the Early Years form
- Supplementary information SEN Support Plans from the last 6 months, other professionals' reports where available

Additional Completion Advice for the ART Form:

- Address and contact details for setting and the parents are essential. Especially mobile numbers. Make clear the address of the setting, particularly if part of a chain.
- What do you want to happen next? What are the expected outcomes for the child? How do you see the EP contributing to outcomes for the child?
- Names of practitioners Add any that are involved rather than just those listed, e.g. Paediatricians, EIO, SALT, Social Care.
- Child/Young Person's Development Describe this under the headings of Communication and Interaction; Cognition and Learning; Social, Emotional and Mental Health; Sensory and Physical; and Self-Care and Independence. Where possible include developmental levels, with an explanation where coded.
- Add the date of the next multi-agency meeting, e.g. Early Help or SEN Support Plan Meeting.
