50% green

There wasn't always evidence to give assurance about the grade chosen. Organisations did make reference to both ICON and DadPad as part of their evidence

A South Glos multi agency audit took place to look specifically at whether fathers and partners had been included when their child has a Child Protection plan or was Child in Need.

In all cases there was an over reliance on information from mothers

Good practice:
One Dad was included from the outset when his child was subject of a CP plan with evidence of his views recorded
