Economy

South Gloucestershire has a diverse economy ranging from rural and home grown small and medium enterprises to world leading companies in key high growth sectors vital to the national economic recovery. These include aerospace, advanced engineering, defence, micro-electronics and silicon design. We host the new Science Park, a world class environment for businesses in science and advanced technology, which incorporates the new National Composite Centre, the national leader on research and design. We are also a centre of excellence for green and environmental technologies, animation and IT solutions. South Gloucestershire is home to the University of the West of England, which plays a key part in supporting high standards of education and training for these cutting edge industries. The Mall at Cribbs Causeway, another major employer, provides extensive retail and commercial services. Both of these attract investment and help create a vibrant economic environment that benefits both businesses and communities.

Working with partners across the West of England and the Local Enterprise Partnership (LEP), we continue to be part of successful partnerships delivering infrastructure and economic development. We support the LEP ambitions to deliver new jobs into the area by 2030, attract substantial private sector investment over the next 5 years, and create a well motivated workforce with the skills to meet business need and to build the foundations for a long term, sustainable economy.

It is important that high level carbon emissions are reduced and that the local economy benefits from the opportunities associated with the transition to a low carbon economy. Local production and consumption and services close to where people live are an important part of this. The area continues to develop and grow but pockets of social and economic deprivation still exist. Helping people back into work as well as raising young people's aspirations through top class educational and vocational experiences will improve personal achievement, social and economic well-being and reduce the gap between prosperity and deprivation. Excellent educational provision underpins a healthy economy which is the bedrock of future success.











Area

With a total land area of 497 sq km, South Gloucestershire is one of the largest unitary authorities in the South West, stretching from the Severn Estuary in the west to the Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) in the east. Its southern boundary borders Bristol, abuts the River Avon and extends almost to Bath. Both the first and second crossing of the River Severn lie within South Gloucestershire and the area is well served by both motorway and rail links. The district has a rich natural and cultural heritage and is an area of diversity and contrast, with a variety of communities, characterised by the special relationship between town and country. Attractive and historic landscapes link unspoilt market towns, villages and established rural and urban communities with major new residential areas, industrial and commercial developments.

Population

South Gloucestershire has been one of the fastest growing areas in the country. Over the period 2001-11 the population of the district increased by 42,400 (+7%) and the number of households increased by 8,500 (+8.5%). The population of South Gloucestershire is 266,100 (ONS, 2012 mid year estimate). This accounts for 5% of the population of the South West. 62% of the population lives in built up areas immediately adjoining Bristol. 18% live in the towns of Yate, Chipping Sodbury and Thornbury, and the remaining 20% live in the more rural areas of South Gloucestershire. The population structure is similar to the national average, with 18.8% of the total population aged 0-15 years; 63.7% aged 16-64 years; and 17.5% in the 65 years and over age group.

Employment

In the year to September 2013, 78.8% of South Gloucestershire's working age population (people aged 16-64) was in employment, which is considerably higher than the national rate (71.4%). From October 2012 to September 2013, the official unemployment rate in South Gloucestershire was 5.4% of the economically active population. This is the lowest rate of the West of England authorities and is considerably lower than the rate for England (7.7%). The unemployment rate in South Gloucestershire has consistently remained below the national average over the last seven years.

Businesses

In March 2013 there were 10,635 local enterprise units in South Gloucestershire, over two thirds (67.4%) were small enterprises employing between 0-4 staff, which is lower than the national average (68.6%). 6,500 of these pay business rates. The district has a larger proportion of very large employers (those employing +100 staff) than the national average. In 2011, South Gloucestershire had a lower rate of business start-ups, but a lower rate of business closures than the national average.

Economy and Skills Partnership

While the scale and pace of economic growth has brought prosperity it has also created major challenges with a substantial increase in traffic, pressure on the transport infrastructure and pressure for more housing on green field sites. A key issue moving forward is how to manage the scale, pace and location of development so as to safeguard the quality of life of people living and working in South Gloucestershire.

The South Gloucestershire Sustainable Community Strategy provides a framework for delivering sustainable development within South Gloucestershire. It aims to address social, economic and environmental issues in an integrated way. To help achieve this ambition the South Gloucestershire Economy and Skills Partnership have set out a vision to 'provide access to first class education and to prosper through a balanced economy, a well-trained workforce and sustainable jobs for all'.

The Partnership's primary purpose is to oversee and help deliver actions that support sustainable economic development in South Gloucestershire and ensure that these actions are consistent with the West of England Local Enterprise Partnership 'functional economic market area' priorities, and the wider national economic agenda.

In particular, the partnership members are there to encourage, support and propose actions that will help achieve the economic development aims set out in the South Gloucestershire Sustainable Community Strategy and the South Gloucestershire Economic Development Strategy:

- **1. Business Competitiveness and Economic Growth -** To improve productivity & competitiveness, and to safeguard and increase jobs in key sectors
- 2. Business Development and Support To increase the number, survival rates and growth rates of starter and small enterprises including social enterprises to maintain a diverse, vibrant, sustainable economy
- **3. Training, Skills and Workforce Development -** To raise aspirations and skill levels through our schools, college and universities and meet the skill and workforce needs of employers
- **4. Education in Our Schools -** to improve standards in our schools so young people realise their aspirations and are well prepared for the future
- **5. Sharing the Benefits of Economic Growth -** To ensure that all parts of South Gloucestershire and all groups share the benefits of economic development, in particular priority areas, rural areas and disadvantaged groups including young people and families
- **6. Employment Land and Premises -** To meet the land, premises and infrastructure requirements of businesses where that is sustainable and consistent with strategic employment and regeneration objectives.
- 7. Town and District Centres To sustain and improve the vibrancy and vitality of town and district centres

South Gloucestershire is an integral part of the West of England, the most strategically significant sub-region within the South West. It is seen as one of the key centres for growth, with Bristol being designated as a 'core city' and the West of England as the economic market area. Rapid growth across the districts presents a number of cross boundary opportunities and challenges, which we cannot deal with alone. The West of England Local Enterprise Partnership is in place to respond to challenges and maximise opportunities across the whole area, building on establishing effective partnership working arrangements to tackle strategic issues such as the economy, waste disposal, housing, cultural facilities and transport.

By Road

South Gloucestershire is well served by the national and regional road transport network. The M4 and M5 motorways place London and Birmingham within a two-hour drive and Cardiff within one hour. The M32 gives direct access from the M4 to central Bristol. www.travelwest.info

By Bike

South Gloucestershire and Bristol City were chosen as England's first official Cycling City in 2008 - making it the country's premier national and international showcase city for promoting cycling as a safe, healthy and practical alternative to the private car for commuting, home-to-school and leisure journeys.

By Rail

Rail services from Bristol Parkway Station at Stoke Gifford provide fast links to London, Birmingham, Cardiff and Southampton. Yate, Severn Beach, Patchway and Filton are connected by local rail services to Central Bristol, Bath and Weston Super Mare. www.networkrail.co.uk

By Air

Bristol International Airport, situated on the A38 eight miles from Bristol, is one of the UK's fastest growing airports. Thornbury Predominantly office and light industrial



Why locate your business here?

The West of England has one of the fastest growing and diversified economies in the UK making it the ideal place for businesses to locate. The area is embracing significant change in the shape of big projects, reform of governance and a sharper competitive edge to doing business. South Gloucestershire Council is collaborating locally to compete globally.

Key investment locations

The West of England offers inward investors a wide ranging choice of business locations with a comprehensive portfolio of office, industrial, warehousing, R&D facilities and mixed development sites over the 1,800 hectares of land which make up the Enterprise Zone and 5 Enterprise Areas, including 750,000 sq m of prime office space and 1.6 million sq m of industrial and warehousing. The Economic Development and Transport Funds secured under the City Region Deal will be used to put in place infrastructure and services required for the development of each of the Enterprise Zones and Areas and their inter-connection.

The Bristol and Bath Investment Service

Invest Bristol & Bath is the investment promotion agency for the Bristol and Bath region, part of the West of England Local Enterprise Partnership and supported by the four Local Authorities of Bath, Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire. 
